- Leading and managing operations of the Springfield site to ensure quality outcomes for customers including the management of individualised support packages;
- Participating in accommodation workforce planning and recruitment to ensure there is optimum staffing numbers available to fill rosters;
- Promoting an ongoing culture of continuous quality improvement for the site; and
- Understanding the customer's funding packages and leading and coordinating the implementation of the associated NDIS plans, or other schemes within the Springfield site.
